The ECIPES Programme is an unprecedented 23 months of work benefiting Moldova, with no support from any stakeholders. The ECIPES Programme¹ is based on a proposal by IDEP Moldova (Moldova's Institute for Project Development and Expertise), for the benefit of citizens, local authorities and young people, regarding a mechanism for obtaining EU support directly via a digital programme. This programme was proposed (in meetings/letters/e-mails/questions from Members) by the Commission, to be implemented in Moldova. IDEP Moldova is not requesting any support for its organisation and has acted as a platform for discussions and debates with key players. The ECIPES Programme is an precedented 23 months of work benefiting the country, with no support from any stakeholders.

- 1. Can the Commission organise a joint working group led by the EU Delegation to Moldova to carry out an impact study in relation to the ECIPES model?
- 2. In the answers to the 10 written questions from Members, the Commission misunderstood the request. The Commission normally engages in self-notification where written questions from several Members are similar in content, organising related thematic debates. Can the Commission re-examine all of the answers and organise a debate on support via a digital programme for citizens, local authorities and young people?
- 3. The ECIPES Programme complies with EU legislation and the EU-Moldova Association Agreement. Could the Commission comment on the points raised?
