- 1. How far were the Frontex and Operation Irini vessels from the location of the shipwreck, and were they informed of the search and rescue call?
- 2. Did any surveillance aircraft call the distressed vessel?
- 3. What is the Commission going to do about Italy and Malta ignoring distress calls and letting over 130 people die?
