Subject: European Solidarity Corps

On 15 April 2021, the Commission published the first call for proposals for the new European Solidarity Corps 2021-2027.

To be eligible to take part, organisations need a quality label. Public and private bodies can apply for financial support via the national agencies for the European Solidarity Corps based in all Member States and in the third countries associated with the programme. In addition, groups of young people registered on the European Solidarity Corps Portal may directly apply for funding to develop and lead their own solidarity projects<sup>1</sup>.

Unfortunately, the participating organisations, bodies and groups are not listed on the European Solidarity Corps Portal<sup>2</sup>.

1. Why are the participating organisations, bodies and groups not publicly disclosed on the Commission's dedicated website?
2. What organisations, bodies and groups are involved in the Solidarity Corps?
3. Does the Commission know whether the organisations, bodies and groups taking part in the Solidarity Corps belong to the left of the political spectrum?
