Subject: Implementation and implications of the Agreement to Prevent Unregulated High Seas

Fisheries in the Central Arctic Ocean

The EU, together with a number of countries around the world, has signed an agreement to prevent unregulated high seas fisheries in the Central Arctic Ocean (Council Decision (EU) 2019/407 of 4 March 2019) for a period of 16 years. The agreement also plans to establish a joint programme of scientific research to better understand the ecosystems in the Central Arctic Ocean and to determine whether there are any fish stocks that could be harvested sustainably.

- 1. How can the Commission ensure that the agreement to prevent unregulated high seas fisheries in the Central Arctic Ocean is properly implemented?
- 2. How is the Commission contributing to the joint programme of scientific research and monitoring?
- 3. What progress has been made with regard to the creation of a regional fisheries management organisation in the Arctic and the establishment of marine protected areas?
