Subject: Roadworthiness tests

Since 20 May 2018, Member States have had to apply the provisions laid down in Directive 2014/45/EU on periodic roadworthiness tests for motor vehicles and their trailers. Furthermore, under Article 2(2), Member States may exclude certain vehicles registered in their territory from the scope of application of the directive. On 27 April 2021, the European Parliament adopted a resolution on the implementation report on the road safety aspects of the Roadworthiness Package, calling on the Commission to consider ending that exception.

1. Have any Member States excluded two- or three-wheel vehicles from the scope of application of Directive 2014/45/EU, under Article 2(2), indent 7?
2. Have any Member States excluded vehicles used exclusively on small islands or in sparsely populated areas from the scope of application of Directive 2014/45/EU, under Article 2(2), indent 5?
