Subject: Symbolic recognition of the United Europe of Peoples

On 12 September 1683, the diplomat Beato Marco d'Aviano intervened to save the city of Vienna and the entire continent of Europe from a barbarous Ottoman invasion. According to historians of note, this gave birth to the concept of a 'United Europe of Peoples'.
