Subject: Invasion of Melilla

In the past week, hundreds of African migrants have stormed the Spanish enclave of Melilla, injuring a number of Spanish border guards. These migrants, who appear from the photographs to be Muslims, are now, together with over four million others, illegally present on EU territory (Pew Institute).

- 1. How many border guards does Frontex intend to send to reinforce the EU external borders in the Spanish enclaves of Melilla and Ceuta against a further invasion?
- 2. What arrangements have been made so far with the Moroccan border authorities to end these attacks on the Spanish enclaves?
- 3. Does the Commission consider this attack on the EU external border as a threat to its security?
