Subject: EU emergency aid for flood victims

The storms and rainfall in recent weeks led to devastating floods in some EU countries. Thousands of citizens have had to leave their homes – some will not be able to return. - 3. Do the objectives of the Green Deal play a role in the allocation of funds and has the Commission adopted an opinion in this regard?
