Subject: Reasons for the low rate of deportations from the EU

According to Eurostat, in 2020, there were 627 900 people from third countries in the EU without a residence permit. Out of this group, 491 195 persons were notified of the legal requirement to leave the EU Member State concerned. However, only 142 320 persons (around 29%) actually left the Member State concerned.

- 1. Is the Commission aware of the reasons why the rate of deportations of illegal residents in the EU is so low?
- 2. Does the Commission know in how many cases the state had to use coercive measures in order to ensure the removal of the 142 320 persons referred to above?
- 3. Does the Commission know how many of the 142 320 persons left the Member State concerned voluntarily?
