Subject: Global Education Summit in London

The EU wants to recruit a total of 69 million teachers internationally by 2030. Of these teachers, a total of 17 million are to be deployed in Africa. A total of EUR 1.7 billion will be allocated to the Global Partnership for Education, to which the EU is the largest contributor.¹

1. What objectives are being pursued by this initiative?
2. What criteria are being used to select teachers?
3. Will separate or further training be provided for teachers in addition to the classical and state-specific teacher training already offered in the individual Member States?
