Subject: Restoration of Tito's yacht *Galeb* should not extol the Yugoslav Communist dictator

The restoration of Tito's official yacht, the Galeb, is scheduled for completion next year.

The vessel will be a cultural and tourist attraction and its refurbishment is set to cost around EUR 7.8 million, much of which met by a grant from the EU. It seems that the on-board museum will devote considerable space to the life of the Yugoslav Communist dictator.

In light of the above, can the Commission state:

- 1. How it will ensure that the image of the Yugoslav dictator is not extolled or amplified, when after the war he abolished parliamentary freedoms and paved the way for mass exterminations, including the killing of thousands of Italians in the *foibe*, and forced over 300 000 Italians to emigrate?
- 2. How it will ensure those exiles from Istria and Dalmatia are accorded due respect after they have suffered so much?
