Question for written answer E-004512/2021 to the Commission Rule 138 Virginie Joron (ID)

Subject: COVID 'vaccine' and children's health

On 29 September 2021, Slovenia suspended use of the Janssen vaccine¹ following the death of a 20-year-old woman. The previous day, Pfizer had announced that they were seeking approval for their vaccine to be administered to children aged 5 to 11².

In Europe, each government has a different vaccination policy. The French Government has embarked on a 'vaccination' programme for children aged 12 to 17. In Sweden, Germany and Switzerland, for the same age group, either vaccination has been delayed or take-up is low³.

According to the European Medicines Agency, COVID 'vaccines' have caused more than 6 000 deaths⁴⁵ in the EU. Doctors have reported adverse reactions in more than 400 babies under the age of 2 years old (including 147 under the age of 1 month old⁶)! In France, 208 children were reported to have suffered serious medical side effects (paralysis in 10 cases) after they received the Pfizer vaccine⁷.

- 1. How many babies and children have died or suffered serious medical side effects in Europe after receiving 'COVID vaccinations'?
- 2. How many cases of paralysis or deaths of healthy children does the Commission consider to be enough for a product to lose its conditional authorisation?
- 3. Why has the Commission authorised vaccinations for healthy infants under the age of one month old⁸?
