Subject: Ivermectin and COVID-19

Multiple studies have identified Ivermectin as a very effective treatment for COVID-19. Unlike the experimental SARS-CoV-2 vaccines, this medication has been used for 30 years and proven to be completely safe.

1. How does the Commission legally justify granting experimental vaccines an authorisation for their emergency or conditional use when there is a tried-and-tested, safe remedy available?
2. Does it have precise figures on the possible harm caused by the vaccines to date? Can it give an idea of how many unreported cases of vaccine injury there might be?
