Subject: Using EU funds to finance facilities at the EU's external borders

In early October 2021, a number of Member States called on the Commission to provide for the financing of a physical barrier at the EU's external borders<sup>12</sup>. In early November 2021, the President of the European Council, Charles Michel, published a paper stating that it would be legally possible to contribute such a measure. The Commission has so far opposed the idea.

- 1. Is the Commission still against (co-)financing a physical barrier at the EU's external borders?
- 2. Based on its own assessment, does it think this would be legally possible?
- 3. Will it take action in response to the Member States' request and if so, will it allocate funds from the EU budget and which funds will it use?
