Subject: List of 34 particularly vulnerable products

In its staff working document on strategic dependencies and capacities updating the 2020 new industrial strategy, the Commission identifies 34 particularly vulnerable products<sup>1</sup>. According to the document, these products were identified because of their low potential for diversification (having a Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI) score of higher than 0.4) and a high price difference (at least 30 %) between extra-EU imports and total EU exports. However, the document only gives a few examples of the 34 particularly vulnerable products.

1. Can the Commission provide the complete list of these 34 particularly vulnerable products?
2. Can the Commission also provide the HHI and the price difference percentages between extra-EU imports and total EU exports for each of the 34 particularly vulnerable products?
