Subject: Disbursement of EU funds in Spain in 2021

In the General State Budget for 2021, the Spanish Government included estimated expenditure of EUR 27 billion in EU recovery funds (EUR 2 billion from REACT-EU, 9 billion from Recovery and Resilience Facility pre-financing and EUR 16 billion from the first tranche of aid).

However, according to estimates by the Fundación de las Cajas de Ahorros (Funcas)¹, and less than one month before the end of the 2021 financial year, the Spanish Government has disbursed only 5.7% of the EU recovery funds budgeted for this year.

- 1. As far as the Commission is aware, how much of its EU funds has Spain disbursed in 2021?
- 2. The Spanish Government has estimated that there will be a cumulative increase in the country's GDP levels of 2.8%, 4.15% and 4.16% and a cumulative increase in its employment levels of 1.2%, 2.9% and 3.1% in the first three years of the implementation of its National Recovery and Resilience Plan². Given the very low implementation rate expected in 2021, does the Commission consider those forecasts realistic?
