Subject: Rule of law in Hungary and Poland

The judgments and their implementation in Cases C-619/18 and C-192/18 are of interest in the case of Poland. As regards Hungary, the judgment in Case C-235/17 is of interest. The Commission is asked to answer the following questions separately:

1. In the Commission's assessment, has the Polish Government complied fully with the judgments in Cases C-619/18 and C-192/18 and, in the Commission's assessment, has the Polish Government fulfilled all the legal obligations arising from those judgments to amend national laws to bring them into conformity with EU law, in particular with regard to judicial independence and the compensation to be paid to the judges concerned?
2. In the Commission's assessment, has the Hungarian Government complied fully with the judgment in Case C-235/17 and, in the Commission's assessment, has the Hungarian Government fulfilled all the legal obligations arising from that judgment to amend national laws to bring them into conformity with EU law, in particular with regard to restrictions on the free movement of capital and indirect discrimination against foreign nationals?
3. Where the issues have not yet been resolved to its full satisfaction, has the Commission proposed that the Court of Justice of the European Union impose fines for non-compliance with EU law? If not, why not?
