Subject: Commission's rejection of Europe's cultural heritage

In its document 'European Guidelines for Inclusive Communication' the Commission has once again demonstrated its categorical rejection of Europe's traditions and cultural heritage, as seen for example in the way it refrains from using the term 'Christmas'.
