Subject: Establishment of a European Child Guarantee

The Commission is asking the Member States swiftly to adopt the Proposal for a Council recommendation establishing a European Child Guarantee. The governments are being asked to submit their national action plans for its implementation to the Commission within six months of its adoption.

1. Does the Commission see a danger here of creating a migration incentive scheme in which children are sent on ahead as anchors?
2. Which EU funds will be drawn on for the implementation of measures at national level, and to what extent?
3. Should children who are not EU citizens and who have legitimate asylum status immediately be given the right to citizenship of an EU Member State in the future?
