Subject: Airlines operating 'ghost flights' to keep airport slots

Airlines are required to use at least 80% of their allocated slots in order to keep them from one season to the next. This rule was relaxed during the pandemic. However, the situation seems to have taken a turn for the worse, with airlines having to operate 'ghost flights' to reach the quota and avoid losing their slots. This practice is clearly at odds with the Green Deal objective.
