## Question for written answer E-000090/2022 to the Commission Rule 138 Cindy Franssen (PPE)

Subject: Transposition of the second revision of Directive (EU) 2019/130

Over 100 000 European workers die from work-related cancer every year. The Commission has been imposing restrictions on 27 carcinogenic substances in the workplace since 2014.

The second revision of Directive (EU) 2019/130 has been in force since 20 February 2019, with Member States being required to transpose it into national law by 20 February 2021 at the latest. However, the Commission's reply of 1 May revealed that four Member States (Austria, Cyprus, France and Spain) had not yet transposed the revised version of the directive into national legislation.

- 1. Can the Commission confirm whether these four countries have done so in the meantime?
- 2. If not, what steps has it taken to urge them to comply?
