Subject: Communications between the Commission and the World Economic Forum (WEF)

Letters concerning the communications between the Dutch cabinet and the WEF were recently made public in the Netherlands. In the letters, the Dutch cabinet members were thanked for their contribution to the objectives of the WEF, including 'The Great Reset'. Only after repeated parliamentary questions, however, was the content of the letters revealed.

In view of this:

1. Are contacts taking place between Commissioners and Klaus Schwab or other WEF representatives? Are they taking place through internal correspondence or communications? Which members are being contacted or are permanently in touch?
2. What is discussed or referred to in such communications?
3. Will the content of communications with the WEF be made public in order to ensure transparency?
