Subject: Relaunch of the EU-US Migration Platform

The United States and European Union have relaunched their Migration Platform. The idea is for the two parties to meet up twice a year to exchange views on developments in their respective migration and asylum policies. The points for discussion include 'challenges arising from the situation in Afghanistan', 'the prevention of irregular migration' and 'the fight against migrant smuggling and human trafficking'.
