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Subject: EU's preparation for a fourth round of COVID-19 vaccine doses despite numerous warnings about serious side-effects

Publications show that the EU is preparing a fourth round of COVID-19 vaccine doses¹. In doing so, the EU is ignoring the alarming warnings of the European Medicines Agency that boosters could lead to problems with immune response².

1. Why is the Commission ignoring the alarming warnings of experts – this time the European Medicines Agency – related to side-effects caused by COVID-19 vaccines?
2. Is the Commission willing to accept full personal civil and criminal liability for existing and future side-effects related to COVID-19 vaccines after choosing not to stop or pause the next rounds of vaccinations and to set aside these reports that warn of serious side-effects?
