Subject: Expansion of a landfill for non-hazardous waste in the municipality of Scala Coeli

By Executive Decree No 14284/2019, the Calabria regional administration issued the environmental impact assessment and integrated environmental permit for a project to expand a landfill for non-hazardous waste at Case Pipino in the municipality of Scala Coeli.

Meanwhile, in support of the EU's transition to a circular economy, Directive (EU) 2018/850 amending Directive 1999/31/EC introduced restrictions on the landfilling of municipal waste that can be recycled and the total amount of municipal waste that can be landfilled.

National and regional measures in this area thus seem completely outdated and are at odds with European guidelines.

In view of the above:

1. Does this project to expand the landfill in Scala Coeli comply with Directive 2008/98/EC as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/851 on waste, and Article 4 on waste hierarchy in particular?
2. Does it comply with Directive 1999/31/EC as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/850 on the landfill of waste?
3. Will the Commission take appropriate action with a view to ensuring compliance with the above-mentioned directives?
