Subject: 'Europe Trust' Foundation as a financier of radical mosques, educational facilities and lobbying associations

In a report on the financial flows of the English 'Europe Trust' Foundation, a Muslim Brotherhood which is active throughout the world, the newspaper 'Die Welt' of 12 October 2021 mentions a 2014 report on the Muslim Brotherhood commissioned by the then Prime Minister David Cameron, which was once again looked at by the UK Parliament in 2020.

According to the report, Europe Trust distributes millions to European Islamist organisations classified by intelligence services as radical and anti-democratic from Markfield in the United Kingdom. The Austrian and German intelligence services are taking action over this legalist Islamism, which 'is attempting, insidiously and inconspicuously, to erode the basic principles of freedom and democracy'.

1. Is the Commission aware of the report commissioned by Cameron and of Europe Trust as a source of financing for radical groups?
2. What kind of data and information exchange on Islamist groups is there between the EU and the UK?
3. Have financial flows to associations such as DMG, Furkan Vakfi, al Furqan, Cordoba Foundation, izdb and similar UK associations attributed to the Muslim Brotherhood been identified at EU level?
