Subject: Nord Stream 2 – hydrogen

On 5 August 2021 the 'Wasserstoff-Hanse' hydrogen network was set up in Rostock in the presence of Gerhard Schröder, Minister for Energy Christian Pegel and the Prime Minister of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Manuela Schwesig. The aim of the project appears to be to press on with repurposing the Nord Stream 2 pipeline in order to supply Europe with blue hydrogen produced in Russia.

- Is repurposing of that pipeline or other Russian pipelines compatible with the EU Hydrogen Strategy?
- 2. What non-European hydrogen production sources does the Commission regard as suitable and useful in terms of its hydrogen strategy?
- 3. What is the Commission's assessment of the production capacities of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania and what role does the region play in the EU Hydrogen Strategy?
