Subject: Frontex activities in the Levante and Northern Africa

Under the EU4 Border Security project, the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) is involved in capacity building for border surveillance and control in North African countries and the Levante. In this connection, Frontex has carried out visits to Tunisia, Morocco, Jordan, Lebanon, Israel and Palestine. Some border authorities of these countries subsequently visited the Frontex headquarters in Warsaw.

1. What activities is Frontex carrying out in Tunisia, Morocco, Jordan, Lebanon, Israel and Palestine, and what missions to these countries by high-ranking members of the Agency have there been in the last two years?
2. Which specific authorities from these countries have subsequently visited the Frontex Headquarters in Warsaw, and what events or meetings did Frontex organise in this context with which other stakeholders?
3. Which of Frontex's activities in North Africa related to border surveillance and control in Libya, and what arrangements did the Agency enter into in this regard with the government visited?
