Subject: Demand for energy resources

The war between Russia and Ukraine is raising concerns that gas, oil and coal deliveries to the EU may stall or be brought to a complete halt. If a suspension in deliveries were to endure, this could cause serious problems for the EU.

1. To what extent can the EU's energy supply be maintained?
2. What steps is the Commission taking to prepare for the possibility of the war, and therefore the shortage of energy resources, continuing?
3. Will it shorten authorisation procedures for the construction of installations that produce energy from sustainable sources, such as wind turbines, with a view to achieving energy self-sufficiency?
