Subject: Splitting of the EU-Mexico Global Agreement

A delegation of Members on the European Parliament's International Trade Committee recently held a series of meetings in Mexico with Mexican Government representatives, senators, employers, trade unions and civil society organisations.

At one of the meetings, the Deputy Minister for Foreign Trade of the Ministry of Economic Affairs, Luz María de la Mora Sánchez, said that the Mexican Government had not yet received the formal proposal from the European Commission on how to split the EU-Mexico Global Agreement.

In the light of the above:

1. To make it easier to ratify, does the Commission plan to split the EU-Mexico Global Agreement into its trade, investment and political dialogue and cooperation parts?
2. Can the Commission confirm whether the information provided by Ms de la Mora is correct? If so, when will the Commission send the Mexican Government the formal proposal on how to split the agreement?
3. Can the Commission provide information on the timetable for the start of the ratification of the agreement?
