Question for written answer E-001102/2022 to the Commission Rule 138 Izaskun Bilbao Barandica (Renew)

Subject: State of play with regard to the implementation in the Member States of Framework Decision 2008/675/JHA

If the Commission has carried out any further assessment of the implementation in the EU as a whole or in Spain in particular of Framework Decision 2008/675/JHA (COM(2014)0312 final) since its assessment in the report of 2 June 2014, I am not aware of it. The shortcomings in the transposition of that framework decision in Spain have already given rise to a number of court cases at the European Court of Human Rights, none of which have resolved the underlying issue. Nor has a decision been taken on the Spanish courts' refusal to refer a question to the Court of Justice of the European Union for a preliminary ruling on the interpretation of Article 3(5) of Framework Decision 2008/675/JHA. Spain is currently considering amending Organic Law 7/2014 to bring it into line with that decision, the provisions of which are key to building the mutual trust on which the common criminal justice area is based.

- 1. Have the Member States rectified the shortcomings identified in the 2014 report?
- 2. If not, have infringement procedures on that matter been opened?
- 3. Would Spain's amendment of OL 7/2014 bring it closer into line with that framework decision?
