Subject: Ban on Grindr in China

Grindr, a dating app for gays and for bisexual and trans men, has not been available in several app stores in China since 27 January 2022. China announced a digital 'clean-up operation' just a few days before Grindr disappeared from app stores there. Shortly before the opening of the Winter Olympics on 4 February 2022, the Cyberspace Administration of China reported that it would be stepping up its net monitoring for a month.

- 1. What is the Commission's assessment of the ban on Grindr in China?
- 2. Does the European External Action Service intend to raise this issue with the Chinese authorities and, if it does, when and with what arguments?
- 3. Does the Commission consider that the EU should link economic cooperation with China to fundamental rights issues and, if it does, to what extent?
