Subject: Inflation and Commission actions

At the beginning of 2022, Commissioner Breton warned that inflation could become a long-term problem. According to news media reports, he said 'I know that some economists say it's temporary. I believe it is probably stronger than that, we have to be prepared for that.

I would therefore like to ask the Commission to answer the following questions separately:

1. Is it planning to propose changes to already presented legislative proposals that risk accelerating inflation? If so, what changes would be made to which proposals? If not, why not?
2. Is it planning to pause or abort its ongoing debt issuance if inflation reaches a certain level? If so, which debt issuance programmes would be concerned, to what degree and at what inflation level? If not, why not?
