Economic damage owing to lack of data protection regulations Subject:

The Austrian and French data protection authorities have classified Google Analytics as illegal and have also linked the justification for this decision to the invalidation of the Privacy Shield.

I call on the Commission to answer the following questions separately:

- What is the Commission's estimate of the economic cost of banning Google Analytics in the EU?
- What is the Commission's estimate of the costs that companies in the EU have had to incur so far to adapt their data processing as a result of the invalidation of the Privacy Shield?
- How much responsibility does the Commission accept or how much economic support is it willing to provide for causing the costs referred to in questions 1 and 2?
