Subject: EU food security and the Green Deal

The war in Ukraine is raising doubts about the EU's food security, especially as regards cereals, as they are primarily imported from Russia and Ukraine.

More broadly, although there are exceptions within the European Green Deal to minimise the impact of its implementation, the EU still has a long way to go before it becomes self-sufficient when it comes to food supply. According to a Commission study<sup>1</sup>, implementing the Green Deal will reduce cereal and oilseed production by 15%.

Will the Commission do away with the unreasonable objectives of the Green Deal to guarantee food security for EU citizens?
