Subject: Proposal for the establishment of a European Arms Register

While holding the EU Presidency in the first half of 2021, the Portuguese Government suggested including firearms and their owners in the so-called Prüm Decisions. The creation of a European Arms Register would be a good initiative which could be used, for example, to register weapons used or intended to be used by EU Member State vessels.

- 1. Is the Commission moving ahead with the creation of the European Arms Register or planning to include firearms in the so-called Prüm Decisions? What would the implementation timetable be?
- 2. Would it consider Estonia as one of the candidate countries for the hosting of the European Arms Register database given that eu-LISA's headquarters are in Tallinn and there is already high-quality expertise on site?
