Subject: Use of satellites with ships radar for maritime surveillance

A number of companies have satellites with a ships radar for maritime surveillance. This makes it possible to locate ships that switch off their AIS transponder. Until now, this capacity was reserved for military earth observation only.

- 1. Does EMSA know of commercial suppliers of satellites with ships radar for maritime observation? What is its assessment of these capacities?
- 2. Using this technology, could specific ships be identified, including from their radar signature?
- 3. Is EMSA considering the procurement of such capacities, or a call for tenders for services of this kind?
