Subject: Fisheries – domestic advisory group

In its resolution of 5 April 2022 on the future of fisheries in the Channel, North Sea, Irish Sea and Atlantic Ocean in the light of the UK's withdrawal from the EU¹, Parliament 'calls for representatives of the fisheries sector, regional authorities, coastal communities and other stakeholders to be actively involved in the monitoring and implementation of the Trade and Cooperation Agreement, in particular through their participation in the domestic advisory groups and the Civil Society Forum provided for by Articles 13 and 14 of the agreement' (paragraph 46). In the resolution, Parliament also 'urges the Commission to promote the establishment of a domestic internal fisheries advisory group to that effect, without prejudice to the existing advisory councils'.

In the light of the above:

Will the Commission be pushing for a domestic advisory group on fisheries to be established within the framework of the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement?
