Subject: Helicopters for Frontex

In Lot 4 of the call for tenders Frontex/OP/694/2020/JL/MS, the European Border and Coast Guard Agency sought a company to carry out 'rotary wing surveillance Missions'. Frontex intended to spend EUR 30 million, including the provision of information via a 'remote mission portal' and the live streaming of raw data. However, no contract was awarded.

- 1. Following the call for tenders Frontex/OP/694/2020/JL/MS, why did Frontex not award a contract for 'rotary wing surveillance missions' and how many tenders were submitted?
- 2. To what extent does Frontex plan to issue a new call for tenders for such services and what is the estimated value of the framework contract?
- 3. For which types of operations does Frontex need helicopters, and for what reasons can these requirements not be met by manned or unmanned fixed-wing aircraft?
