Subject: Cooperation agreement between EMSA and EUNAVFOR MED

Since 2015, EMSA has provided AIS satellite data to the EU military mission EUNAVFOR MED. A new cooperation agreement will allow EUNAVFOR MED access to EMSA's Integrated Maritime Services platform. This includes the 'automated recognition' of vessels' behaviour or of their movements. Using such means, the military mission aims to monitor Libyan ports and maritime transport.

- 1. What systems does EMSA have in place to detect and process AIS data and to what extent can such data also be received via satellites?
- 2. What systems does EMSA have in place for the automated recognition of vessels' behaviour and which manufacturers installed them at the Agency?
- 3. What other services of EMSA's Integrated Maritime Services platform can the EU military mission use under the new cooperation agreement?
