Subject: Visit of Filip de Winter and Geert Wilders to municipalities in Brussels

On 13 May 2022, Filip de Winter invited Geert Wilders to join him on a walk through a number of municipalities in Brussels. Together they wanted to experience what it was like to walk the streets of those municipalities. It was not a demonstration, but simply two individuals who wanted to move freely on European soil.

However, several mayors denied them access. At the Sint-Joost-ten-Node border, they were stopped by the police and prevented from entering the municipality on the basis of a police order.

- 1. How is this ban reconcilable with the Union's fundamental principle of freedom of movement?
- 2. How does the Commission view the fact that citizens are being denied access to certain municipalities on the basis of their political persuasion?
- 3. Under EU law, do local mayors have the right to establish 'no-go' zones for certain citizens on the basis of political persuasion, even though political persuasion is a protected characteristic?
