Subject: Progress of infringement cases against Slovakia, Czechia and Hungary concerning

discrimination against Roma children in their education systems

Since 2015, the Commission has been pursuing infringement proceedings against three Member States for infringements of the EU Racial Equality Directive 2000/43 concerning the unjustified and disproportionate placement of Roma children in special or practical schools, their segregation and discrimination. The countries concerned are Czechia, Slovakia and Hungary. These countries are grossly violating one of the fundamental rights of children – access to quality education.

In this context, what is the state of play of these infringement proceedings, how does the Commission assess the implementation of the inclusion measures that these Member States have taken in response to these infringement proceedings, and how does the Commission intend to act in these proceedings?
