Subject: Europe's Beating Cancer Plan

In February 2021 the Commission presented the Europe's Beating Cancer Plan, which is divided into four key action areas and covers the entire disease pathway in 10 flagship initiatives. There is a need for sustainable measures and measures enabling the EU to maximise added value. What is needed most of all, however, are specific and immediate measures for combating cancer in Europe effectively. To fund the Europe's Beating Cancer Plan, the Commission has earmarked a total budget of EUR 4 billion.

1. What specific measures have already been carried out or are being carried out?
2. In which areas and for which measures has investment already been made?
3. On the basis of what criteria are budget funds being spent and allocated, and for what projects or measures is the bulk of the funding being made available?
