Subject: Protests in Pakistan

Pakistan is currently facing a fresh wave of violent protests led by Islamist organisations, which are particularly pervasive in the country.

In addition, ousted prime minister Imran Khan did not hesitate to pay tribute to Bin Laden.

Yet the country still benefits from a cooperation agreement with the European Union, notably in relation to the Generalised System of Preferences.
