Subject: European Parliament legislative resolution providing exceptional macro-financial assistance to Ukraine

On 15 September 2022, Parliament adopted a legislative resolution on a proposal for a decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on providing exceptional macro-financial assistance to Ukraine, reinforcing the Common Reserve Fund with guarantees by Member States and establishing specific provisioning of certain financial commitments relating to Ukraine guaranteed under Decision No 466/2014/EU and amending Decision (EU) 2022/1201 (hereinafter 'the Resolution'). The resolution indicates that EUR 9 billion have been provided to Ukraine by the European Union so far under the first phase of the Union's planned exceptional macro-financial assistance.

In view of the above:

1. How many euro in total, together with the above-mentioned macro-financial assistance of EUR 9 billion, has the EU budget so far provided to Ukraine?
2. From which funds or from which budget lines have the funds referred to in the first sentence been provided to Ukraine?
3. What is the mechanism for controlling the use of the funds provided? Who is authorised to verify the eligibility of the use of EU budget funds provided to Ukraine? What are this person's competences?
