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Subject: Failure to investigate excess mortality

More and more publications point to excess mortality as a continuing phenomenon. New diseases such as 'sudden adult death' have originated since the COVID-19 vaccination campaign and healthy young (active) people are suddenly dying¹.

1. Can the Commission explain why it refuses to investigate this excess mortality and its relationship to COVID-19 vaccines?
2. Does it rule out any possible connection between COVID-19 vaccines and excess mortality?
3. Does the Commission have any relevant data, including cause of death, whether or not proven, and vaccination status – of every deceased person in the EU since the start of the COVID-19 vaccination (trial)? If so, will it disclose such data?
