Subject: Pro-Russia coverage on Euronews

Key figures from the Ukrainian media community have written an open letter to Euronews, which it has also addressed to the Commission, complaining about pro-Russia coverage on the channel. They state that the Russian-language version of Euronews is engaging in wholesale media manipulation on the subject (i.e. the war in Ukraine) on a daily basis and imperceptibly imposing on viewers a pro-Russian understanding of the cause-and-effect relationship of what is happening in Ukraine.

1. What action has the Commission taken since 13 September 2022, when these allegations, concerning coverage broadcast between 15 and 19 August 2022, came to light?
2. If the allegations are true, what does the Commission intend to do concerning the substantial funding what Euronews receives?
