Subject: General Elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina

On Sunday 2 October general elections were held in Bosnia and Herzegovina. In accordance with the 1995 Dayton Agreement, the country is composed of two distinct entities. One of these is the Republika Srpska, where those most in favour of retaining the Republic's structural integrity saw a decisive electoral victory.

Although the inhabitants of Republika Srpska have always made their fervent opposition to this process known, the European Union has once again appealed for the accession of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
