Subject: Sanctions suspending state-owned media outlets Russia Today and Sputnik in the EU – Part II (urgent follow-up questions)

In my question for written answer E-002793/2022, I asked whether the broadcasting activities of Russia Today and Sputnik had now been suspended in all 27 Member States and for more details if there were any cases in which they had not. In her answer of 10 October, Vice-President Jourová merely stated that there had been 'limited, temporary problems regarding the distribution online' and that the Commission was 'considering further action against Russian propaganda channels, including to ensure the effective implementation of already adopted measures'. In view of this:

1. Exactly what problems were encountered in which Member States (please provide details for each of the 27 Member States)?
2. Which specific measures will the Commission take to bring the activities of Russian propaganda channels to a halt?
3. Can state-owned Russian media outlets definitely now no longer broadcast in the EU?
