**Subject:** Manipulation of officially published COVID data by Hugo de Jonge, the former Dutch minister of Health, Welfare and Sport

It is clear from published documents<sup>1</sup> that Hugo de Jonge, former Dutch minister of Health, Welfare and Sport, had corona data manipulated before it was made public. This manipulation created an image of a 'pandemic of unvaccinated people'. This deliberately false image contributed to support for measures such as the COVID-check system, which infringed citizens' rights and freedoms.

1. Can the Commission specify what data regarding COVID, including numbers of infections, deaths, hospital admissions, vaccinations – broken down by vaccination status where applicable – it has received from the Netherlands?
2. Can the Commission explain in what way it has used the data referred to in question 1, including in policy-making and in calculation models, studies and publications?
3. Is the Commission at liberty to make the data referred to in question 1 public?
